Company Name	Description	Deal Synopsis
Crimson Midstream	Provider of crude oil transportation and storage services in California, Louisiana, and offshore Gulf of Mexico. The company's assets are generally pipelines and related facilities acquired from major oil companies offering sustainable, cost-effective midstream service to its customers.	The company received an undisclosed amount of development capital from The Carlyle Group on January 14, 2019. The funds will be used to enhance the company's support of shippers on its Gulf of Mexico, Louisiana and California pipeline systems and grow its presence.
Discovery Midstream Partners	Operator of a full-service midstream oil and gas company. The company is engaged in the processing, storing, transporting and marketing of oil, natural gas and natural gas liquids. It also develops infield systems and production facilities with improved run time and reduced fuel consumption, enabling customers to spend less on surface equipment and receive higher returns.	The company received \$1 billion of development capital from Stonepeak Infrastructure Partners on January 7, 2019.
East Cheyenne Natural Gas Storage	12 billion cubic foot natural gas storage facility in Logan County, Colorado. This facility offers services to utilities, power generators, pipelines, producers and marketers that require storage to meet gas demand.	East Cheyenne Natural Gas Storage was acquired by Enstor Gas from Midstream Energy Holdings, via its financial sponsor ArLight Capital Partners, through an LBO on January 8, 2019 for an undisclosed sum.
